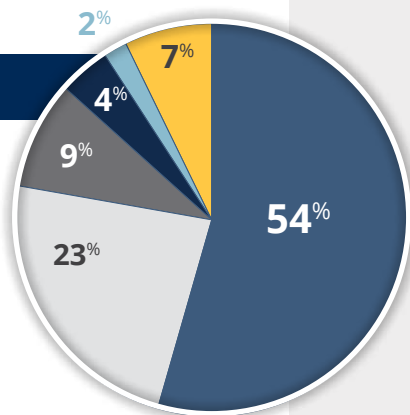

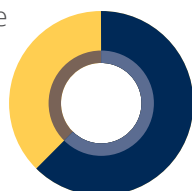

The Fischl Gallery hosts exhibitions throughout the year.



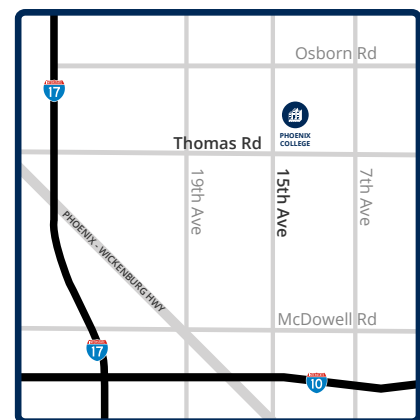
MUSICAL PERFORMANCES
